The City of Meigs, Georgia will receive sealed Bids for all material, labor and equipment for the 2008 CDBG I & I Sewer Rehabilitation Project City Hall, 1006 E. Depot Street, Meigs, Georgia, 31765, up to **2:00 PM**, prevailing local time, on **January 12, 2010** and then publicly opened and read aloud. All interested parties are invited to attend. This Advertisement for Bid is intended to meet the requirements of Georgia Code Section 36-91-2, as amended by SB146.

The Work of this Project generally consists of 10,000 LF of cleaning and televising sanitary sewer lines, 2,100 LF of cured in place pipe, 17 sewer point repairs, 100 manhole repair items, 1 pump station rehabilitation, 1,350 LF of forcemain installation, etc. with all related accessories and appurtenances as shown on the Drawings and called for in the Contract Documents.

Bids shall be on a unit price basis with lump sum prices for certain items of the Work.

A compact disk containing these documents in portable document format (.pdf) may be obtained at the same location upon payment of \$50.00. Priority overnight shipping with purchase is an additional \$50.00 per set. There will be no refunds or return of Bidding Documents. All payments for bidding documents shall be cash or check only. Direct the request, with payment, to the office of the Engineer.

The purchaser must supply the telephone and facsimile numbers along with street address of the individual or firm to whom addenda (if any) can be directed. Visit <http://www.speng.com> for a list of Bidding Document holders on this Project. Then click on “Bids & Projects” to view a project out for bid or under construction. All requests for technical information from Bidders shall be sent to the Engineer by facsimile or email only up to 72 hours prior to bid date.

A Bid Security in the sum not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the Bid will be required with each Bid. Form of Bid Security shall be in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

Each Bidder is required to submit a “Bid form”, “Bid Bond”, “Form of Qualification of Bidder” and “Non-Collusion Affidavit”, and “Immigration and Security Forms” as outlined in Section 00250.

This Contract is funded with a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and requires the use of prevailing wage rates. Bidders are required to complete specific funding requirements that are included in Paragraph 6.09 of the Supplementary Conditions. Other specific funding requirements are included in the Project Manual.

All anticipated federal, state, or local permits required for the project have been obtained by Owner. A list of these permits is included in Paragraph 6.08 of the Supplementary Conditions. The Engineer shall be contacted should any work be required in the GA Department of Transportation (GDOT) right-of-way. A DOT permit application might be applicable, and at that time the Engineer will obtain the DOT permit.

All anticipated rights-of-way and easements required for the project have been obtained by Owner. A list of the easements along with any special requirements is indicated in Paragraph 4.01 of the Supplementary Conditions.

No Bidder may withdraw their Bid within sixty (60) days after the date of Bid opening.

Owner will not engage in unlawful discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, age, sex, height, weight, marital status, or unrelated disability. Bids from minority- and female-owned organizations are encouraged.

The right is reserved by Owner to accept any Bid, to reject any Bid, and to waive irregularities in Bids.
